

Maintenance and cleaning instructions Zorin - for 100% wool felts

Treatment of wool felt:

It cannot be washed, it cannot be spun, it can only be ironed, it can be dry cleaned. Can be vacuumed.

Detailed operating instructions:

Wool felt is one of the oldest man-made textiles. Zorin 100% wool felt is of high quality, environmentally friendly, durable, excellently dyeable and perfectly usable for the implementation of demanding, unique design applications.

As with all natural fibers, a minimal approach should always be taken to cleaning wool felt.

- The following order of cleaning methods is recommended:
- (1) dust removal with a lint roller,
- (2) gentle vacuuming with a clean vacuum brush head,
- (3) cleaning with a mild detergent solution,
- (4) application of a chemical stain remover.

Always test the cleaning method first on an inconspicuous area before starting cleaning.

It is recommended to use a vacuum cleaner to remove general dirt and dust particles that get into the felt from the air. In case of contamination, clean thoroughly with mild soap and lukewarm water. Avoid aggressive rubbing, as this may initiate a further felting process and change the surface of the felt. Once a year, it is advisable to gently vacuum the surface of the panels with a vacuum cleaner. In the case of a clean office environment, it is enough to do this every 18 month.

We would like to draw your attention to the fact that the slight "falling" of the wool fibers from the felt is a natural process and does not affect the properties of the felt in any way. Remove these fibers from the felt with a light vacuum cleaner. This shedding, if it occurs at all, decreases continuously, and stops after a while. In the event of a wet spill, wipe up the liquid with a dry cloth as soon as possible to avoid absorption. Avoid aggressive rubbing.
